Michigan Drainfield will always make its best effort to perform every service as though we were working on our own home. We will assess the site to the best of our ability to determine if our Renew Drainfield Restoration process is suitable for your drain field. Certain septic systems will not be a suitable candidate for restoration. When we can determine by visual assessment that a system is unsuitable, we will make alternate recommendations. Michigan Drainfield will NOT be responsible for the following:

1. Damage to or as a result of any underground public utility which is not marked or is marked incorrectly.
2. Damage to or as a result of any underground private utility (non-public customer owned electric wiring, plumbing, gas lines, sprinkler systems, unknown tanks or any other underground abnormality) which is not marked or exposed by the property owner.
3. Damage to any grass, trees, or landscaping.
4. Damage to trench drain systems. Our system has proved effective in restoring many of these systems, however, there is a remote possibility that the fracking process could damage the system necessitating spot repairs or possibly total replacements. In the even Michigan Drainfield cannot be held liable. Michigan Drainfield, or its affiliates, can make the repair or replacement but the cost is totally separate and in addition to the Renew Drainfield Restoration cost.

The customer, by contracting to have this service performed totally and unconditionally indemnifies and holds harmless Michigan Drainfield, its parent company, Michigan Waste and Environmental Services Inc, and all subsidiaries any loss occurring from any of the above listed occurrences.
